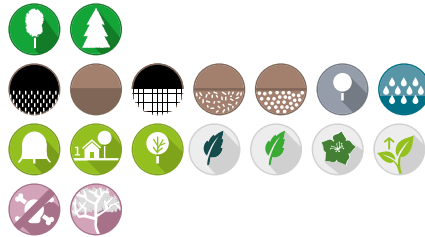




Sequoiadendron giganteum

'Pendulum'



Výška	approx. 15 m
Šírka	3-4m
Koruna	broadly weeping, very irregular, light, open crown, capricious growing
Kôra a vetvy	reddish brown and soft, fibrous trunk, deeply grooved
Listy	needles scaly and sharp, bluish green, 1 - 1.2 cm, evergreen
Kvety	unremarkable
Plody	upright cones, hanging when ripe, reddish brown, 5 - 8 cm
Tŕne	Žiadny
Jedovatosť	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
Typ pôdy	all, preferably very nutritious
Pôdna vlhkosť	Vhodné do vlhkých pôd
Spevnené plochy	Netoleruje spevnené plochy
Zóna odolnosti	7a (-17,7 do -15,0 °C)
Odolnosť voči vetru	moderate
Tvar	Vysokokmeň, Vzorový ihličnan

A conifer with a bizarre growth pattern, with branches hanging down sharply, but some growing in a more or less horizontal, undulating pattern. These branches have young, very thin twigs that hang straight down. The main trunk sometimes grows in a somewhat undulating fashion as well. This ultimately produces an exceptional, irregular growth pattern that is pre-eminently suited for solitary planting. The growth pattern is quite similar to that of the cultivar 'Barabits Requiem', however the branches of 'Pendulum' grow less far to the side. Height approx. 15 m and width 3 - 4 m. 'Pendulum' is slightly weaker than 'Barabits Requiem'. Trunk, branches, needles and cones are similar to those of the species. Requires protection against cold wind. Difficult to transplant.
