



Acer palmatum 'Dissectum'



Výška	3 - 4 m

Koruna	flat-topped spherical, mushroom-shaped, dark, dense crown, capricious growing
Kôra a vetvy	smooth, grey-brown
Listy	palmatifid with 7 deeply dissected leaf segments, mid-green
Jesenné sfarbenie	Oranžová
Kvety	red flower corymbs, May
Plody	single seeds, winged, always in pairs, pink
Tríne	Žiadny
Jedovatosť	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
Typ pôdy	any, except clay, and not too dry

Low, broad shrub, with widely overhanging branches if grafted onto a stem. The leaves are palmate and the leaf segments are also dissected nearly to the main veins. The young leaf is light green to yellowish green. The summer leaf is mid-green. In autumn it turns flaming orange to light red. ‘Dissectum’, previously also traded widely as the variety *dissectum viride*, gives its name to all of the “Dissectum Group”. A common characteristic of this cultivar group is that the leaf segments of the palmatifid leaves are very deeply dissected.
