



# Acer platanoides CONQUEST

## ('Conzam')



<b>Výška</b>	10 - 12 m
<b>Šírka</b>	6-8m
<b>Koruna</b>	ovoid, dark, dense crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	bark dark grey, branches light brown
<b>Listy</b>	5/7 lobes, dark red to purplish green
<b>Jesenné sfarbenie</b>	Oranžová, Červená
<b>Kvety</b>	yellow-green, in corymbs, before the leaf development
<b>Plody</b>	winged nutlets (samara), 3.5 - 4.5 cm long
<b>Tŕne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Má jedovaté časti
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	any soil, except peat
<b>Pôdna vlhkosť</b>	Odolné voči krátkodobému zaplaveniu
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje čiastočné spevnenie
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	4 (-34,4 do -28,9 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	not very sensitive, not resistant to sea wind
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1–6)
<b>Stromy pre zvieratá a hmyz</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1–6), Cenné pre motýle
<b>Použitie</b>	bulváre a široké ulice, úzke ulice, priemyselné oblasti
<b>Tvar</b>	Vysokokmeň
<b>Pôvod</b>	Lake County Nursery, Perry, OH, USA, 2009
<b>Synonymum</b>	Acer platanoides 'Conquest'

Grows in nearly columnar pattern when young, later becoming somewhat broader, eventually developing an ovoid crown. Originated as mutant of 'Crimson King' and has the same shiny, dark red leaf. This is especially noticeable in spring. Later in summer, the leaf turns purplish green to dark green; the young shoots still present provide an attractive colour combination. In autumn, the leaf turns orange-red. The cultivar somewhat resembles 'Crimson Sentry', but has a stronger root system. Highly suitable for narrower avenues and streets, and on squares. Grows on any soil, but does not tolerate stagnating groundwater and peaty soils.
