



## Acer pseudoplatanus 'Negenia'



<b>Výška</b>	15 - 25 m

<b>Koruna</b>	broad pyramidal, dark, dense crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	twigs olive green to grey, bark grey
<b>Listy</b>	5-lobed, dark green, leaf stems red, about 14 - 20 cm
<b>Kvety</b>	yellow-green, in pendent racemes, April
<b>Plody</b>	winged nut (samara), 3 - 3.5 cm long
<b>Tŕne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Má jedovaté časti
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	any
<b>Pôdna vlhkosť</b>	Odolné voči krátkodobému zaplaveniu

<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	very good, even sea wind

The cultivar 'Negenia' is a Dutch selection with a healthy and vigorous habit. Medium-sized to large tree reaching a height of circa 25 m. The wide pyramidal crown has a regular habit. The large leaves are dark green and have a red leaf stalk. Flowers and fruits are of the species. The flowers emerge while the leaves unfold and are then followed by the winged nutlets. 'Negenia' is suitable as a solitary and can be applied in avenues, parks and streets. The tree demands little from the soil, it is even tolerant to poor soil conditions. The wind resistance is very good, even better than of other cultivars. Winter hardiness zone: 4
