



## Aesculus 'Laciniata'



<b>Výška</b>	10 -12 (15) m
<b>Šírka</b>	4-6m
<b>Koruna</b>	narrow pyramidal, half-open crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	a thin, brown, smooth bark
<b>Listy</b>	palmatifid, 5/8 leaflets, dark green, 10 -15 cm
<b>Kvety</b>	very strongly reduced, inconspicuous
<b>Plody</b>	none, fruitless cultivar
<b>Tŕne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	all
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje spevnenie
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	6 (-23,3 do -17,8 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	moderate to good
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6)
<b>Použitie</b>	malé záhrady
<b>Tvar</b>	Vysokokmeň
<b>Pôvod</b>	A. & L. Leroy, Angers, France, 1843
<b>Synonymum</b>	<i>Aesculus hippocastanum</i> 'Laciniata'

A graceful tree of average height with a striking leaf. Each leaf is palmately divided into 5 to 8 leaflets. These have various shapes, but each one is deeply lobed. (*laciniata* is Latin for “deeply lobed”). This narrow leaf shape is sometimes thin as a thread. This produces a very decorative tree.
