



## Celtis julianae



<b>Výška</b>	20 - 30 m
<b>Šírka</b>	12-15m
<b>Koruna</b>	umbel-shaped, half-open crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	twigs dark brown with yellow-brown hairs, bark grey, smooth
<b>Listy</b>	elliptical to ovate or obovate, 6 - 13 cm, tip tapering
<b>Jesenné sfarbenie</b>	Žltá
<b>Kvety</b>	green, inconspicuous, April/May
<b>Plody</b>	round drupe, purple to orange, 1 – 1.5 cm
<b>Tŕne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	well drained soil, tolerates drought
<b>Pôdna vlhkosť</b>	Vhodné do suchých pôd
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje spevnenie
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	6 (-23,3 do -17,8 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	slightly susceptible
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1–6)
<b>Použitie</b>	bulváre a široké ulice, priemyselné oblasti
<b>Tvar</b>	Vysokokmeň
<b>Pôvod</b>	Central China

Fast growing, large tree with a fairly loose, umbel-shaped crown. The long, projecting and overhanging first-year twigs give the tree an elegant appearance. The twigs are dark brown, turning grey later. The leaves vary in shape from ovate to elliptical or obovate. The leaf's underside has yellow to orange-yellow hairs, sometimes only on the veins. The inconspicuous flowers are followed by purple to orange, round drupes. Prefers warm summers. Prefers well-drained soil. Can tolerate drought and air pollution.
