



## Cercis siliquastrum 'Alba'



<b>Výška</b>	6 - 10 m
<b>Šírka</b>	6-10m
<b>Koruna</b>	round, half-open crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	grey, somewhat grooved when mature
<b>Listy</b>	round to kidney-shaped, 4 - 9 cm, green
<b>Kvety</b>	creamy-white to dirt? white, in clusters, April/May
<b>Plody</b>	brown, flat pods
<b>Tŕne</b>	žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	calcareous sandy or loamy soil
<b>Pôdná vlhkosť</b>	Vhodné do suchých pôd
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Netoleruje spevnené plochy
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	6b (-20,5 do -17,8 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	moderate
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6)
<b>Stromy pre zvieratá a hmyz</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Cenné pre včely (medonosné)
<b>Použitie</b>	malé záhrady, dvory
<b>Tvar</b>	Vysokokmeň, Viackmeň
<b>Synonymum</b>	Cercis siliquastrum f. albida

Originated as a natural variety of *C. siliquastrum*, originally growing in the Mediterranean area. Sturdy shrub form that can grow into small to medium size, sometimes multi-stemmed tree. As a tree, the crown is round. The round to kidney-shaped leaves are mid-green. The flowers often appear before the leaves develop. They are creamy white to dirty white and stand in compact clusters. Can blossom very profusely as a tree. The pods persist all winter. This warmth-loving tree prefers a fertile, calcareous or loamy soil in full sun. Tolerates dry soil.
