



## Crataegus laevigata 'Plena'

<b>Výška</b>	10 m
<b>Šírka</b>	6-8m
<b>Koruna</b>	round, half-open crown, capricious growing
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	twigs grey, with thorns, bark brown-grey, peeling in small platelets
<b>Listy</b>	ovate, 3/5 lobes, very dark green, 3 - 6 cm
<b>Kvety</b>	white, blossoming dirt? pink, full, in panicles, May-June
<b>Plody</b>	none, fruitless cultivar
<b>Tŕne</b>	Áno
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	few soil requirements, prefers fairly heavy soil
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Netoleruje spevnené plochy
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	5a (-28,8 do -26,1 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	moderate
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6)
<b>Stromy pre zvieratá a hmyz</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Cenné pre motýle

<b>Synonymum</b>	Crataegus laevigata 'Alboplena'

Crataegus laevigata 'Plena' is a tree with a dense, broad, more or less rounded crown and it grows up to 10 m in height. The trunk and branches are grey. The branches bear thorns approx. 2.5 cm long and viciously sharp. The leaves are a remarkable dark green and have 3 - 5 lobes. The double flowers grow in umbels and turn from white to dirty pink. 'Plena' is sterile and therefore produces no fruit. It prefers nutritious soils, not too moist. The soil must be sufficiently compact since the tree is sensitive to wind when the root system is not well developed. Can be used in parks, streets and gardens. Winter hardiness zone: 5a
