




Malus 'Cheal's Weeping'



Výška	3 m
Šírka	2,5-3m
Koruna	broad, weeping, half-open crown
Kôra a vetvy	twigs purplish brown, bark dark brown
Listy	oval to elliptical, bronze, purplish-green
Kvety	light lilac-red, flower buds purple-red, May
Plody	red, 2 - 3 cm
Tríne	Žiadny
Jedovatosť	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
Typ pôdy	nutrient-rich, well-drained soil
Spevnené plochy	Toleruje spevnenie
Zóna odolnosti	5 (-28,8 do -23,4 °C)
Odolnosť voči vetru	good, susceptible to sea wind
Ostatná odolnosť	Odolné mrazu (WH 1–6), Odolné vetru

Small tree with gracefully hanging twigs and branches. Usually top grafted and will not grow to much more than approx. 3 m. The sprouting leaf is deep purple-bronze, becoming bronze, purplish green in summer. The purple-red buds open in May. The flowers are fairly large and light lilac-red. They are followed by red crab apples that remain on the tree until into November. Striking thanks to the lovely weeping habit and large flowers in a distinctive colour. Unfortunately, susceptible to scab.
