



## Malus POM'ZAI ('Courtabri')



<b>Výška</b>	3 - 4 m
<b>Šírka</b>	1-2m
<b>Koruna</b>	flat-topped spherical, half-open crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	dark brown
<b>Listy</b>	oval to narrow oval, dark green 6- 8 cm
<b>Kvety</b>	light red, almost white fading, flower buds pinkish red, May
<b>Plody</b>	yellow with orange blush
<b>Tŕne</b>	žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	nutrient-rich, well-drained soil
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje spevnenie
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	5a (-28,8 do -26,1 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	good, susceptible to sea wind

A slowly growing crab apple that is often grafted onto standard. This produces a small tree that's eminently suitable as a solitary in small gardens. Depending on the graft height the tree grows to 3 - 4 m. The crown is flattened spherical. The tree produces abundant flowers, light red fading to almost white. In autumn many small yellow fruits with an orange blush appear and remain in the tree for a long time. The tree grows best in nutrient-rich, not too dry soil. It is a very vigorous hybrid cultivar produced by Sapho in France around 1990.
