



## Malus toringo 'Brouwers Beauty'



<b>Výška</b>	5 - 6 m
<b>Šírka</b>	4-6m
<b>Koruna</b>	broad fan-shaped, half-open crown, capricious growing
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	grey-brown, smooth
<b>Listy</b>	oval, green
<b>Kvety</b>	light pink, buds purplish pink, about 2.5 - 3 cm, April/late May, fragrant flowers
<b>Plody</b>	yellow with orange-red blush, Ø about 1 cm
<b>Tŕne</b>	žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	fertile, well drained soil
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje spevnenie
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	5a (-28,8 do -26,1 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	good, susceptible to sea wind
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Odolné vetru
<b>Stromy pre zvieratá a hmyz</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Odolné vetru, Plody ako potrava pre vtáctvo
<b>Použitie</b>	úzke ulice, stromy do nádob, strešné záhrady, priemyselné oblasti, malé záhrady, dvory

Malus toringo 'Brouwers Beauty' is a tree that grows vertically and has a strong main stem. It eventually assumes a broad fan shape with somewhat overhanging branches. Height and width 5 - 6 m. The oval green leaves have a sharply serrated edge. It produces abundant pale pink flowers. The flowers are single, the flower buds purple-pink. Yellow to orange-yellow fruits, Ø approx. 1 cm, appear in the late summer and remain on the tree until the end of October. For parks, wide streets, green verges and small gardens. Slightly sensitive to scab. Winter hardiness zone: 5a
