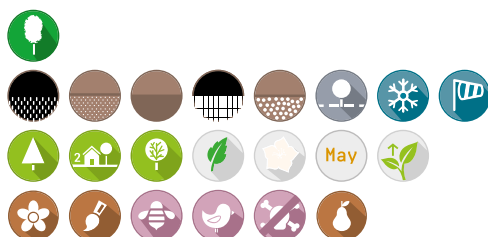




Malus yunnanensis var. veitchii

Medium-size tree with an upright, eventually broad pyramidal crown to approx. 10 m. The ovate leaf has a striking heart-shaped base. It is often lobed with 5 to 7 shallow lobes. It is matt dark green in summer, turning yellow-orange to dark purple in autumn. The buds open around mid-May into creamy white flowers. At less than 2 cm across they are relatively small and are arranged in clusters of 12 to 20 flowers. The small crab apples are produced in abundance. They are dark brown-red with yellowish white dots. Healthy tree for gardens, parks and wide green borders.
