



## Prunus serrulata 'Amanogawa'



<b>Výška</b>	6 m
<b>Šírka</b>	1-1,5m
<b>Koruna</b>	columnar, half-open crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	twigs reddish brown, bark brown, smooth
<b>Listy</b>	elongated to oval, fresh green, 7 - 12 cm, autumn colour orange
<b>Jesenné sfarbenie</b>	Oranžová
<b>Kvety</b>	light pink, semi-double, 3.5 - 4.5 cm, April/early May, fragrant flowers
<b>Plody</b>	seldom
<b>Tríne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	any; not in wet soils
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje spevnenie
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	6a (-23,3 do -20,6 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	fairly
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6)
<b>Použitie</b>	bulváre a široké ulice, úzke ulice, stromy do nádob, malé záhrady, dvory
<b>Tvar</b>	Vysokokmeň, Vetvený, Viackmeň
<b>Pôvod</b>	Japan, 1830

Prunus serrulata 'Amanogawa' is a slow growing large shrub or small tree with a columnar crown that droops somewhat at a later stage. Height up to approx. 6 m. The twigs are reddish-brown and have few lenticels. The lanceolate to oval-shaped leaves have a tapered top and turn orange in the autumn. Produces many flowers from the end of April to early May. The pale pink semi-double flowers have a faint scent and turn white. Seldom produces fruit. For gardens, parks, streets and as a solitary. It does not stand up to wet soil. Winter hardiness zone: 6a
