



## Quercus palustris 'Pendula'



<b>Výška</b>	20 m
<b>Šírka</b>	10-15m
<b>Koruna</b>	round to broad weeping, half-open crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	twigs olive green, bark grey, smooth to shallow grooved
<b>Listy</b>	ovate to broad elliptical, roughly lobed, glossy dark green, 7 - 15 cm
<b>Jesenné sfarbenie</b>	Červená
<b>Kvety</b>	golden coloured ? catkins, May
<b>Plody</b>	flat-topped spherical, approx. 1 cm
<b>Tŕne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	any, preferably fertile, not too limy
<b>Pôdna vlhkosť</b>	Vhodné do vlhkých pôd
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Netoleruje spevnené plochy
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	5a (-28,8 do -26,1 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	good
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Odolné vetru, Odolné posypovej soli
<b>Použitie</b>	priemyselné oblasti
<b>Tvar</b>	Vysokokmeň

'Pendula' has a round to broad weeping, somewhat irregular crown because of the more drooping branches. Eventually the tree can grow to around 20 m tall and wide. Fairly open branched with olive green young twigs, older branches and bark grey and smooth to shallow grooved. The ovate to broad elliptical leaf is lobed to around halfway along the leaf blade. It is glossy dark green, turning red to reddish brown in autumn. An old cultivar that is still rare in culture. The drooping branches make it a typical park tree. Grows in almost any soil and can also cope with a moist soil. Can tolerate air pollution.
