



## Sorbus xarnoldiana 'Golden Wonder'



<b>Výška</b>	8 - 12 m
<b>Šírka</b>	4-5m
<b>Koruna</b>	broad pyramidal to ovoid, half-open crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	grey, smooth, later a little flaky
<b>Listy</b>	imparipinnate, 9 - 17 (21) leaflets, dark green, approx. 20 cm long, feathered leaf
<b>Jesenné sfarbenie</b>	Žltá, Oranžová, Červená
<b>Kvety</b>	in umbels, Ø approx. 15 cm, white flowers, May/June
<b>Plody</b>	ochre-yellow, in large bunches, August
<b>Tŕne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	preferably slightly acid humic soil
<b>Pôdna vlhkosť</b>	Vhodné do suchých pôd
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje čiastočné spevnenie
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	6a (-23,3 do -20,6 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	good
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Odolné vetru
<b>Stromy pre zvieratá a hmyz</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Odolné vetru, Plody ako potrava pre vtáctvo
<b>Použitie</b>	bulváre a široké ulice
<b>Tvar</b>	Vysokokmeň

The S. arnoldiana hybrid is a cross between S. aucuparia and S. discolor. 'Golden Wonder' is a fast-growing cultivar that becomes a medium-sized tree with a broad pyramidal crown. The leaves are imparipinnate and consist of 9 - 17 (21) lanceolate leaflets. These are 5 - 7 cm long and 2 - 3 cm wide and have a finely serrated leaf edge. A remarkable feature is the dark red leaf stem In the autumn the leaves turn pale yellow to orange-red. The large felt-like flower umbels consist of many white flowers. As early as August the ochre-yellow fruits appear, diameter approx. 1 cm. The tree prefers slightly acid humic soil but also flourishes on dry sandy soils.
