



## Sorbus aucuparia 'Fastigata'



<b>Výška</b>	6-8 m

<b>Listy</b>	green, feathered leaf
<b>Jesenné sfarbenie</b>	Žltá, Oranžová, Červená

<b>Plody</b>	red
<b>Tŕne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil, acid soil
<b>Pôdna vlhkosť</b>	Vhodné do suchých pôd
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Netoleruje spevnené plochy
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	4 (-34,4 do -28,9 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	good

*Sorbus aucuparia 'Fastigata'* is a slow grower with remarkably thick ascending branches and twigs, and a height of 6 - 8 m. 'Fastigata' is usually grafted on a stem of *Sorbus intermedia*. This makes it less sensitive to wind. The leaves are larger than those of the species, sometimes as much as 30 cm long, dark green and matt glossy. The underside is bluish-green and the autumnal coloration yellow. The relatively large dark red fruits contrast nicely with the dark leaves. Very sensitive to canker, and thus not worth recommending. Winter hardiness zone: 4
