



## Sorbus 'Dodong'



<b>Výška</b>	10 m
<b>Šírka</b>	4-5m
<b>Koruna</b>	ovoid, half-open crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	twigs brown, bark grey, smooth
<b>Listy</b>	imparipinnate, 20 - 30 cm, with 15 - 17 elongated to narrow ovate leaf segments, glossy dark green, feathered leaf
<b>Jesenné sfarbenie</b>	Oranžová, Červená
<b>Kvety</b>	white, in corymbs, May/June
<b>Plody</b>	orange-red, pear-shaped
<b>Třne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	few requirements, can grow on infertile soils
<b>Pôdna vlhkosť</b>	Vhodné do suchých pôd
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje čiastočné spevnenie
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	5 (-28,8 do -23,4 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	good
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1–6), Odolné vetru
<b>Stromy pre zvieratá a hmyz</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1–6), Odolné vetru, Plody ako potrava pre vtáctvo
<b>Použitie</b>	bulváre a široké ulice
<b>Tvar</b>	Vysokokmeň, Viackmeň

<b>Synonymum</b>	Sorbus commixta 'Dodong'

Medium-size tree, initially with narrow oval crown, eventually with an ovoid crown to 10 m tall and 6 to 8 m wide. Twigs are brown, old bark is grey and smooth. The imparipinnate leaves consist of 15 - 17 leaf segments. They are glossy dark green and in autumn turn intensely orange-red to red. In May and June the white flowers appear in wide corymbs. They are followed by more or less pear-shaped, orange-red fruits that remain on the tree until into winter, provided they are not eaten by birds. Healthy tree that was named in a Swedish research programme. The seed from which 'Dodong' was produced was collected in 1976 by a Swedish-Danish expedition to the Korean island of Ullung Do. Dodong is the name of the island's port.
