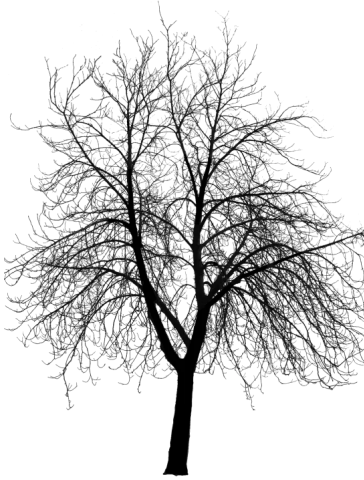
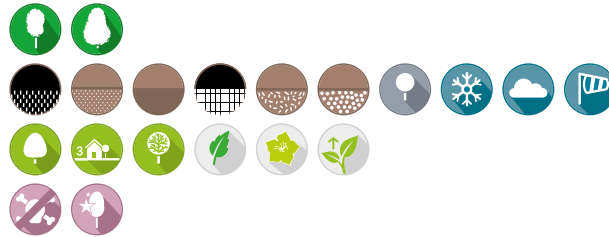




Carpinus betulus ROCKHAMPTON RED ('Lochglow')

ROCKHAMPTON RED is a densely branched cone-shaped, later broadly ovoid tree, reaching a height of about 15 m. In older trees, the branches sag a little. The young leaves are light green, turning dull dark green later in summer. The most striking feature of ROCKHAMPTON RED is its autumn colour. Unlike other *C. betulus*, its leaves do not turn golden yellow but red. As a result, a completely different effect can be achieved with this hornbeam. For example, hedges with a red autumn colour. But also as avenue tree or solitary in gardens and green spaces, it is a beautiful cultivar with special ornamental value. It has few soil requirements and grows best in humus-rich loamy soils. ROCKHAMPTON RED was found by Geoff and Pattie Locke, Rockhampton, UK, and introduced in 2014. Hardiness zone 5a
