



## Ginkgo biloba 'Pendula'



<b>Výška</b>	2 - 2,5 m
<b>Šírka</b>	8-10m
<b>Koruna</b>	broad weeping, light, open crown, capricious growing
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	grey
<b>Listy</b>	green
<b>Jesenné sfarbenie</b>	Žltá
<b>Kvety</b>	green, flowers in April
<b>Plody</b>	fruitless cultivar
<b>Tŕne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	clay soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje spevnenie
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	5a (-28,8 do -26,1 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	fairly to good
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Odolné vetru
<b>Použitie</b>	stromy do nádob, strešné záhrady, priemyselné oblasti, malé záhrady, dvory
<b>Tvar</b>	Vysokokmeň, Vyvetvený ihličnan, Vzorový ihličnan

At first, this cultivar has branches that spread almost horizontally. Later, they hang down. This produces a broad weeping shape. Height depends on the grafting site – usually between 2 and 2.5 m. 'Pendula' is often confused with the cultivar 'Horizontalis', the branches of which grow in a more horizontal pattern, especially at a mature age. The tree grows slowly, rendering it suitable for small gardens, as well. The fan-shaped leaves grow in bundles of 3 - 5 together and have an incised top. 'Pendula' does not turn such striking a colour in the autumn. It requires a site with ample light and tolerates heat well. Winter hardiness zone: 5a
