



Larix kaempferi 'Diana'



Výška	4 - 6 m
Šírka	3-4m
Koruna	pyramidal, light, open crown, capricious growing
Kôra a vetvy	twigs brownish red, very contorted and twisted, bark grey-brown to reddish brown, scaling
Listy	needles, curved and rotated, on short shoots in clusters, single on long shoots, blue-green
Jesenné sfarbenie	Žltá
Kvety	inconspicuous ? 0,5 - 1 cm, yellowish ? reddish brown, 1 - 1.5 cm, April
Plody	oval to round cones, 2 - 3 cm, yellowish brown
Tríne	Žiadny
Jedovatosť	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá

Strong cultivar which grows from a shrub shape into a small tree with a pyramidal crown from 4 to 6 m. The twigs and branches are very contorted and twisted. Like the species, they are brownish red. The quite thick mature bark is grey-brown to reddish brown, later scaling. The soft needles are in clusters of 40 - 50 on short shoots along the older twigs. On (year-old) long shoots, they stand alone. Like the twigs and branches, the blue-grey needles are also very curved and twisted. In autumn, they turn golden yellow before falling off. 'Diana' transforms itself into a graceful tree on all soils except acidic.
