



## Picea pungens 'Fat Albert'



<b>Výška</b>	3-5 m

<b>Koruna</b>	broad conical, dark, dense crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	grey, black
<b>Listy</b>	greengreen, bluegreen, evergreen
<b>Kvety</b>	unremarkable, flowers in May
<b>Plody</b>	green, yellowbrown
<b>Tríne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	clay soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, acid soil, calcareous soil
<b>Pôdna vlhkosť</b>	Vhodné do suchých pôd
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Netoleruje spevnené plochy
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	4 (-34,4 do -28,9 °C)
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6)
<b>Stromy pre zvieratá a hmyz</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Plody ako potrava pre vtáctvo
<b>Použitie</b>	stromy do nádob, strešné záhrady, priemyselné oblasti, malé záhrady
<b>Tvar</b>	Vysokokmeň, Vzorový ihličnan

Broad pyramidal small tree with a very dense and regular branching. This American cultivar grows into a compact tree, 3 to 5 m tall. The needles are intense light blue-grey, spiky, 2 - 3 cm long. The long cylindrical cones are green first, turning yellowish brown when ripening. Its very regular shape and good, compact growth habit make this cultivar very well suited to use in modern designs. Few demands as to soil, provided it is fertile enough and moist. Requires a sunny site. Requires slightly drier conditions than other Picea species and is resistant to urban climate and air pollution.
