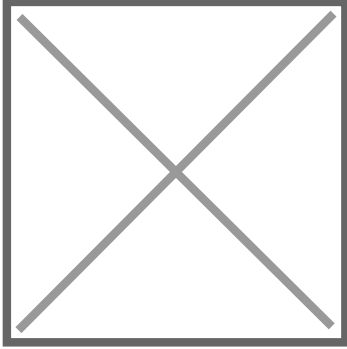




Chitalpa tashkentensis 'Pink Dawn'

Koruna	broad, flat-topped spherical, dark, dense crown

Small tree with a broad, flat-topped, spherical crown. The young leaves are glossy green, the mature leaves matt green. Because they are relatively narrow, they give the tree a delicate structure. The panicles of trumpet-shaped flowers appear in early summer, sometimes with as many as 40 in a cluster. The flowers are about 4 cm in size and light pink with a light yellow centre. They are sterile and do not form fruit. This tropical-looking tree is a hybrid of Chilopsis and Catalpa. It is a warmth-loving tree that tolerates drought. It will grow less strongly in cooler zones. The tree appears to be susceptible to mildew in very humid areas.
