



## Acer campestre 'Baronne'



<b>Výška</b>	6 - 12 m
<b>Šírka</b>	3-6m
<b>Koruna</b>	columnar, dark, dense crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	smooth, light grey-brown
<b>Listy</b>	3/5 lobes, shiny dark green, 8 - 12 cm
<b>Jesenné sfarbenie</b>	Žltá
<b>Kvety</b>	small, terminal corymbs, yellow-green, May
<b>Plody</b>	single seeds, winged, always in pairs
<b>Tŕne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	any soil, except dry, infertile, sandy soil
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje čiastočné spevnenie
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	5a (-28,8 do -26,1 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	good/very good
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Odolné vetru, Odolné posypovej soli
<b>Stromy pre zvieratá a hmyz</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Odolné vetru, Odolné posypovej soli, Cenné pre motýle
<b>Použitie</b>	bulváre a široké ulice, úzke ulice, stromy do nádob, strešné záhrady, pobrežné zóny, priemyselné oblasti

<b>Pôvod</b>	Pépinières Gérard Lalsy & Fils, Lesdain, Belgium, 2000

Discovered by Eric Lalsy in 2000 among a batch of seedlings in his nursery. The tree was notable for the absence of mildew. This columnar, small to medium size tree also grows more strongly than comparable cultivars. The leaves are bigger than with other cultivars, and dark green. The tree is free from red spider mites and mildew. Perfect avenue tree for narrow streets, housing estates, squares and green borders. Does not grow well enclosed by paved surfaces. Light corrective pruning may be necessary for the first four or five years after planting out to attain a good crown shape. The field where the tree was selected is called 'Le Baron', hence the cultivar name.
