Medium-sized tree with a conspicuously slender, columnar shaped crown, turning into a more vase-like shape when maturing. The young twigs are distinctively covered by a bluish white wax coating, a characteristic feature of this cultivar. The shiny, dark green leaves have five forward pointing lobes. In autumn the leaf turns yellow. 'Lobel' is a cultivar that is not tolerant to a high pH like the other cultivars of the *A. cappadocicum*. 'Lobel' is, however, wind resistant and can perfectly be used in hard surfaces. This excellent cultivar is extremely suitable for narrow streets, but 'Lobel' is also very characteristic as a park tree.
