



## Acer rubrum 'Karpick'



<b>Výška</b>	12 - 15 m
<b>Šírka</b>	4-6m
<b>Koruna</b>	columnar to narrow ovoid, dark, dense crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	grey trunk, dark reddish-brown twigs
<b>Listy</b>	palmate, lobed, shiny dark green, leaf stem red, about 10 cm, autumn colour yellow to red
<b>Jesenné sfarbenie</b>	Žltá, Oranžová, Červená
<b>Kvety</b>	red, in small umbels, only male, March/April
<b>Plody</b>	none; male cultivar, fruitless cultivar
<b>Tŕne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	moist, not calcareous
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje čiastočné spevnenie
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	4 (-34,4 do -28,9 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	poor to moderate
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6)
<b>Použitie</b>	bulváre a široké ulice, úzke ulice
<b>Tvar</b>	Vysokokmeň, Viackmeň
<b>Pôvod</b>	Fernrite Nursery, Aurora, OR, USA, circa 1980

Young specimen are very narrow, mature wider. An ideal tree for narrow streets and avenues. Height up to 15 m. A selection with strikingly red-brown coloured twigs. The leaf stalk is red-brown too. The leaf is bright green and can be 10 cm. The underside of the leaf is blue green. Eye-catching yellow to red autumn colours. It is a male variety without flowers or fruits. In limy soil the growth stunts. No autumn colouring in dry soils. Poor tolerance to (sea) wind. Winter hardiness zone: 4
