




## Aesculus 'Homestead'



<b>Výška</b>	8-10 m

<b>Koruna</b>	round/spherical, dark, dense crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	brown, grey
<b>Listy</b>	green
<b>Jesenné sfarbenie</b>	Žltá, Oranžová
<b>Kvety</b>	yellow, reddish, flowers in May
<b>Plody</b>	brown, seldom
<b>Térne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	clay soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, peaty soil
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje spevnenie
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	5 (-28,8 do -23,4 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	moderate
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1–6)

Small to medium-size tree with a rounded crown, which will eventually grow to about 10 m high and wide. The dark green leaf is 5-fingered and turns yellow to orange in autumn. The light yellow to reddish flowers usually open from mid-May to early June. The tree produces hardly any fruit, which means less of a nuisance. Originated from a cross between *A. glabra* and *A. flava*. According to American studies, the tree has adequately vigorous growth, sufficient decorative value in summer, an attractive winter silhouette, and a nice tight crown. It is also very hardy.
