



Fagus sylvatica 'Remillyensis'



Výška	3 - 5 m (depending on graft height)
Šírka	6-8m
Koruna	broad, weeping, dark, dense crown, capricious growing
Kôra a vetvy	smooth, grey bark, soft
Listy	oval to ovate, glossy green, 4 - 10 cm long
Jesenné sfarbenie	Žltá
Kvety	small, inconspicuous flower catkins, May
Plody	nuts, in cupules covered with brushy spines, 1 - 2 cm

A rarity that catches the eye because of its peculiar habit. 'Remillyensis' has an umbrella-like habit with twisted branches. The limbs droop, so that a weeping look is generated. The eventual height depends on the height of the graft union. It is a seldom grown cultivar. The leaf is shiny green and turns to yellow brown in autumn. The inflorescence is inconspicuous and is followed by small nutlets. This cultivar is used as a solitary in small gardens and parks. 'Remillyensis' prefers calcareous, moisture-retentive but well-drained soil that is high in humus content. The tree is intolerant to hard surfaces and a high water table. Winter hardiness zone: 5b
