



# Fraxinus angustifolia

## 'Elegantissima'

<b>Koruna</b>	round/spherical, half-open crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	brown, grey
<b>Listy</b>	green, feathered leaf
<b>Jesenné sfarbenie</b>	Žltá
<b>Kvety</b>	flowers in April
<b>Plody</b>	fruitless cultivar
<b>Tríne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	clay soil, loamy soil, sandy soil, nutrient-poor soil, calcareous soil
<b>Pôdna vlhkosť</b>	Vhodné do suchých pôd, Vhodné do vlhkých pôd
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje spevnenie
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	6b (-20,5 do -17,8 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	good
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Odolné vetru, Odolné posypovej soli
<b>Použitie</b>	bulváre a široké ulice

Fraxinus angustifolia 'Elegantissima' is a slow growing tree with a wide branching spherical crown. The tree can attain a height of circa 8 m. The light green, compound leaf is 15 - 20 cm large and has a finely and sharply serrated margin. It is odd-pinnate with 11 - 13 leaflets. In Autumn it turns strikingly yellow. Does not bear fruits. Is used as a park tree and in wide green belts. The tree has few soil requirements and can withstand drought. Good wind resistance. Winter hardiness zone: 6b
