



## Ilex x aquipernyi DRAGON LADY ( 'Meschick' )



<b>Výška</b>	3 - 6 m
<b>Šírka</b>	2-3m
<b>Koruna</b>	pyramidal, dark, dense crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	young twigs dark green, bark green-brown, smooth
<b>Listy</b>	oval, glossy dark green, very spiky, 4 - 6 cm, evergreen
<b>Kvety</b>	?, white, inconspicuous, solitar? in the leaf axils, May/June
<b>Plody</b>	fleshy drupe, 6 - 8 mm, vivid red
<b>Tŕne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Má jedovaté časti
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	humic, moist but well-drained soil
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Netoleruje spevnené plochy
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	6b (-20,5 do -17,8 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	very good
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Odolné vetru
<b>Stromy pre zvieratá a hmyz</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Odolné vetru, Plody ako potrava pre vtáctvo
<b>Použitie</b>	stromy do nádob, strešné záhrady, pobrežné zóny, malé záhrady, dvory
<b>Tvar</b>	Vysokokmeň, Vetvený, Viackmeň

Small tree with a very regular, densely branching, pyramidal crown, about 3 - 6 m tall. Young twigs are dark green, mature bark is green-brown and smooth. The glossy dark green leaves are oval to almost rectangular, with downward-curling tips. They are 3 - 5 cm long and about half as wide. The margins are very undulate, with 4 - 6 strong, sharp prickles. The flowers are small, fairly inconspicuous and female. They are followed by vibrant red berries 6 - 8 mm across. Sometimes attributed to the hybrid *I. x meserveae*, but originated from a cross between *I. aquifolium* and *I. pernyi*. Prefers a humic, moist but well-drained soil and tolerates either acidic or calcareous soil. As well as its use in parks and gardens it is also suitable for use as a narrow hedge.
