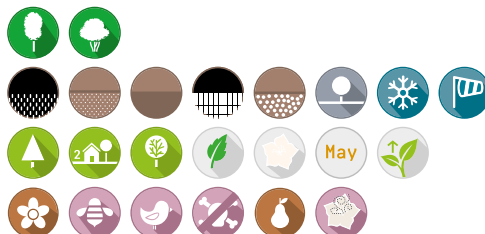




## Malus toringoides 'Mandarin'



Výška	6 - 8 m
Šírka	5-7m
Koruna	broad pyramidal, half-open crown
Kôra a vetvy	twigs and bark dark brown
Listy	ovate with one or two side lobes, dark green
Kvety	white, 2.0 - 2.5 cm mid-late May, fragrant flowers
Plody	yellow with red blush, 1.5 - 1.8 cm
Tríne	Žiadny
Jedovatosť	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
Typ pôdy	nutrient-rich, well-drained soil
Spevnené plochy	Toleruje spevnenie
Zóna odolnosti	5b (-26,0 do -23,4 °C)
Odolnosť voči vetru	good, susceptible to sea wind
Ostatná odolnosť	Odolné mrazu (WH 1–6), Odolné vetru

Medium-size tree with a broad pyramidal crown, to about 8 m. The dark green leaf is ovate and has one or two pairs of side lobes so it looks like it has 3 to 5 side lobes. The flower buds are white, as are the open flowers. They are 2 to 2.5 cm and blossom quite late; around mid to late May. The lavishly produced fruits are round to pear-shaped and measure approx. 1.5 to 1.8 cm. They are yellow with a red blush. This cultivar was received, named and marketed by the the Netherlands Inspection Service for Horticulture (NAKB) from England (East Malling Research Station). Moderately susceptible to scab.
