



## Nyssa sylvatica 'Autumn Cascades'



<b>Výška</b>	12 m
<b>Šírka</b>	6-8m
<b>Koruna</b>	broad, weeping, half-open crown, capricious growing
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	twigs greenish brown, bark dark grey, grooved
<b>Listy</b>	ovate to oval, glossy dark green, 7 - 15 cm
<b>Jesenné sfarbenie</b>	Žltá, Oranžová, Červená
<b>Kvety</b>	inconspicuous, greenish, April/May
<b>Plody</b>	ovoid drupe, dark blue, Ø 0.9 - 1.5 cm
<b>Tŕne</b>	žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	prefers loamy soil, not too dry
<b>Pôdna vlhkosť</b>	Vhodné do vlhkých pôd, Odolné voči krátkodobému zaplaveniu
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Netoleruje spevnené plochy
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	5a (-28,8 do -26,1 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	moderate
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6)
<b>Stromy pre zvieratá a hmyz</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Plody ako potrava pre vtáctvo
<b>Použitie</b>	stromy do nádob, strešné záhrady
<b>Tvar</b>	Vysokomeň, Vetvený, Viackmeň

Nice weeping shape of black tupelo whose branches arch gracefully even when young. The glossy dark green leaves are obovate to oval. At 7 to 15 cm they are significantly larger than the species. In autumn they turn deep yellow and orange to scarlet over a period of weeks. The autumn colour partly depends on the soil type in which the tree stands. The root growth is deep making transplantation difficult. *N. sylvatica* grows naturally in marshy sites but this tree can also thrive well in less moist places.
