'Grosse Späte Schwarze Knorpelkirsche' is a sweet cherry with a semi-open crown of 6-8 m in height. The crown is broad ovoid and slightly irregular in shape. The tree blooms around the end of March with white blossom and is not self-pollinating. Another cherry variety is therefore needed to guarantee that the tree bears fruit. Preferably, 'Hedelfinger Riesenkirsche' or 'Schneider's Späte Knorpelkirsche' are used for this purpose. The cherries of 'Grosse Späte Schwarze Knorpelkirsche' are ready for picking from mid-July to mid-August. They are large and shiny dark purple-red to almost black-red. The flesh is very juicy and pleasantly sweet. The cherries are very suitable for both direct consumption. Hardiness zone 6.
