



## Salix alba 'Chermesina'



<b>Výška</b>	10 - 15 m, fast growing
<b>Šírka</b>	6-10m
<b>Koruna</b>	broad ovoid, half-open crown, capricious growing
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	twigs orange-red to red, yellow-brown to grey, deep corky grooved
<b>Listy</b>	lanceolate, bright green, 6 - 12 cm long, dark green
<b>Kvety</b>	yellow ? catkins, about 5 cm long, April
<b>Plody</b>	none; male cultivar, fruitless cultivar
<b>Tŕne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	moist and wet, preferably calcareous
<b>Pôdna vlhkosť</b>	Vhodné do vlhkých pôd, Odolné voči krátkodobému zaplaveniu, Odolné voči dlhodobému zaplaveniu
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje spevnenie
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	4 (-34,4 do -28,9 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	good
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Odolné vetru
<b>Stromy pre zvieratá a hmyz</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1-6), Odolné vetru, Cenné pre motýle

Salix alba 'Chermesina' (syn. S. alba britzensis) is a male cultivar that grows to become a medium-large tree with an approx. height of 10 - 15 m. It is sometimes used as a pollard willow. The trunk has deep, corky grooves. The decorative value of the orange-red to red twigs is striking. 'Chermesina' is a remarkable sight, particularly in the winter months. Frequent pruning stimulates the growth of new, strikingly coloured twigs. The lanceolate leaves are dark green and have silvery hairs. Grows in moist to wet places. Winter hardiness zone: 4
