



## Tamarix tetrandra



<b>Výška</b>	4 - 5 m
<b>Šírka</b>	4-5m
<b>Koruna</b>	fan-shaped , light, open crown, capricious growing
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	black bar, twigs shiny and dark reddish brown
<b>Listy</b>	scaly, tapering to a point, bright green, 0.1 – 0.5 cm
<b>Kvety</b>	in tight clusters, light pink, April/June
<b>Plody</b>	unremarkable fruit capsules
<b>Tŕne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	parks, small gardens, coastal areas
<b>Pôdna vlhkosť</b>	Vhodné do suchých pôd, Odolné voči krátkodobému zaplaveniu
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Netoleruje spevnené plochy
<b>Zóna odolnosti</b>	6a (-23,3 do -20,6 °C)
<b>Odolnosť voči vetru</b>	good
<b>Ostatná odolnosť</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1–6), Odolné vetru
<b>Stromy pre zvieratá a hmyz</b>	Odolné mrazu (WH 1–6), Odolné vetru, Cenné pre včely (medonosné)
<b>Použitie</b>	stromy do nádob, strešné záhrady, priemyselné oblasti, malé záhrady, dvory
<b>Tvar</b>	Vysokokmeň
<b>Pôvod</b>	south-eastern Europe and Western Asia

Large bush that grows into a small tree with pendulous twigs. The nearly black bark is slightly grooved at a later age. The twigs are shiny and dark reddish brown. The scaly, narrow, oval leaves are bright green and have a semi-perfoliate base. Leaves on young twigs are oval and 0.4 - 0.5 cm wide, on older branches much smaller, approx. 0.1 cm. Small pale pink flowers grow in tight clusters, 4 - 6 cm long. The crown leaves fall off quickly, but the 4 stamens remain a long time. After flowering, small capsule fruits containing plentiful seeds appear. This Tamarix is excellently suited for coastal areas. When the plant is not blooming, it bears a superficial similarity to some conifers.
