



## Tilia heterophylla 'Prestige'



<b>Výška</b>	12 - 15 m
<b>Šírka</b>	5-6m
<b>Koruna</b>	narrow ovoid, half-open crown
<b>Kôra a vetvy</b>	twigs red, bark dark brown, grooved
<b>Listy</b>	broad ovate with broad retuse base and long pointed tip, glossy dark green, 8 - 13 cm
<b>Kvety</b>	in corymbs 10 - 20 together, cream-coloured, July, fragrant flowers
<b>Plody</b>	ovate, Ø circa 0.8 cm, brown, felt-like hairs
<b>Tríne</b>	Žiadny
<b>Jedovatosť</b>	Zvyčajne nie je jedovaté pre ľudí a väčšie zvieratá
<b>Typ pôdy</b>	any, provided well-drained
<b>Spevnené plochy</b>	Toleruje spevnenie

Large tree with a distinctly more slender crown than other linden species and cultivars. The tree grows to approx. 15 m tall and 6 m wide. The young twigs are red, mature bark is dark brown and grooved. The gracefully shaped, broad ovate leaves have a retuse base and a long pointed tip. Its margin is finely and sharply serrated. The top of the leaf is glossy dark green, the underside white felt-like and light brown on young leaves. In July the fragrant, cream-coloured flowers, 10 - 20 together, appear in approx. 8 cm long corymbs. They are followed by brown, felt-like hairy ovate fruits. This cultivar was first distributed in the USA under the synonym, 'Continental Appeal'. A good avenue tree that can be used mainly in places where other lindens are too wide.
